The following information outlines the programme fee, scholarship opportunities, payment options, and related terms for the **Certificate Programme in Policy Analysis & Clinic** offered by **Samaira Policy Research Institute (SPRI)**.

Certificate Programme in Policy Analysis & Clinic (PAC)

All amounts in INR (₹)

All amounts are in Indian Rupees (₹) and apply to the Certificate Programme in Policy Analysis & Clinic. The fee is all-inclusive, as set out below. Where anything differs, the official admission notice and the brochure prevail.

Programme Fee

The all-inclusive fee, and what each component covers.

Total programme fee.

The total programme fee is ₹18,000 (Rupees Eighteen Thousand only), and it is all-inclusive. There is no separate application or registration fee.

Fee component.

The ₹18,000 covers every component of the programme, as follows:

Scholarship

Concession up to ₹6,000 on the tuition fee awarded on Merit and EWS grounds.

In brief: Concession **up to ₹6,000** on tuition fee will be awarded on two grounds — **merit** (CV & SOP shortlisting, and an interview) or **EWS** (EWS certificate).

Criteria for scholarship.

Scholarship of **up to ₹6,000** may be availed on the tuition fee. So the amount payable is between ₹12,000 - ₹ 18,000. The scholarship is offered on two grounds — **Merit** and **Economically Weaker Section (EWS)** status.

Merit based Scholarship

- **Stage 1 — shortlisting:** applicants are shortlisted on curriculum vitae (CV) and statement of purpose (SOP) submitted with the main application form.
- **Stage 2 — interview:** shortlisted candidates appear for an interview on an assigned public-policy theme — on which they demonstrate their understanding, interpretation and sense of the issue's practical relevance in society.

EWS based Scholarship

- Certificate obtained online or offline through designated local government authorities.
- Documents such as an income certificate issued by a revenue authority, IT returns, Form 16, or bank statements showing income within the required threshold.

A scholarship of up to ₹6,000 is awarded on this evaluation.

Payment

Ways to pay, instalment options and the governing terms.

The options depend on whether a scholarship has/not been awarded:

- **One time payment (₹18,000):** pay either in a single payment, or in three installments of ₹6,000 each at the beginning of the course, at mid-course, and after completion (the third month).
*certification will not be provided if the 3rd instalment isn't paid.
- **Scholarship recipients (Merit or EWS):** the scholarship-reduced fee is payable in a **single, one-time payment**; the instalment option is not applicable on scholarship-reduced fees.
*Instalments are not applicable for Scholarship students.
- **EWS recipients — payment flexibility:** for EWS scholarship recipients only, flexibility in the payment structure may be considered on a case-by-case basis. Please contact the institute's helpline to discuss.
